A. Executive Council Initiatives

NEW GOALS

1. Should the HSCB Executive Council accept the Domestic Violence Prevention Committee's Work Plan Recommendations, to establish a Safe and Together Work Group which will be the implementation group for the Work Plan recommendations. Lead: Inter-Agency Initiatives Steering Committee
2. In cooperation with Easter Seals, support the advancement of a trauma-informed child welfare system in Macomb County as projects are approved for collaborative action by the HSCB Executive Council. Lead: Easter Seals
3. Explore a collaborative relationship with Operation Rx. Leads: Health Department and MCCMH/MCOSA

CONTINUATION GOALS

1. Continue to explore the development of an inter-agency portal of services platform using a pilot site to initiate and work through the system of care issues involved in such an inter-agency project. Lead: Department of Veteran's Services
2. In the second quarter of calendar 2017, OneMacomb will complete grant-funded activity intended to create an ongoing community-based collaborative group for discussion and action related to diversity and inclusion in Macomb County. Government agencies, non-profit organizations, and private sector businesses are all potential members of this collaborative. Since all HSCB member agencies experience the impact of the county's increasing diversity, they will wish to know what the new entity is doing and may wish to be active participants. The OCE's representative on the Executive Council will be the liaison and facilitate linkages between the HSCB and the new entity. Lead: County Executive Office

B. State/Federal Initiatives

CONTINUATION GOALS

1. Explore how Martha T. Berry Medical Care Facility, Macomb County Community Mental Health and Senior Services can work together to facilitate and integrate services for seniors with issues of mental health and dementia who are now dual eligible in the ICOs. **Lead: Martha T. Berry Medical Care Facility**
2. Continue to maintain awareness of state and federal initiatives related to:
 - A. The reception of significant numbers of refugees and the potential impact on county services (*i.e.*, human services, linguistic access, rights and responsibilities, education to the American system, etc.).
 - B. Health and human services fiscal, policy changes and/or quality of care changes. **Lead: HSCB Executive Council**
3. Receive reports on the status of the State's Prosperity Regions. **Lead: HSCB Executive Council**

C. Local Initiatives

CONTINUATION GOALS

1. Continue to work collaboratively with Great Start Macomb as they implement the goals in or being considered for their Strategic Plan in those areas that are HSCB-related and those goals in the HSCB Annual Working Agenda that are Great Start-related. **Lead: HSCB Executive Council and Great Start Macomb**
2. Based on the results of the MSU survey, MSUE will bring to the HSCB Executive Council table relevant areas that require local collaboration for consideration. **Lead: Macomb MSU Extension**
3. Continue to work around local issues affecting veterans, *i.e.*, transportation, employment, faith-based involvement in recognizing veterans. **Lead: Department of Veteran Services**
